Advisory: Airport Connector construction

What: Paving on Charles City Road, related to Airport Connector road construction.

Duration: Beginning Monday, Aug. 30, and continuing throughout the week.

Details: Charles City Road will remain open. Flaggers will temporarily stop and direct traffic as necessary to ensure safety in the work zone.

Where: Charles City Road, at and around the intersection with Airport Drive

Safety: Drivers should expect short delays and plan their trips to allow extra time to reach their destinations. Drivers are encouraged to use caution and avoid distractions while driving through the construction zone.

About the Airport Connector: The 1.6-mile Airport Connector will link Pocahontas 895 to Charles City Road and Airport Drive to lead directly into the heart of Richmond International Airport. The new road will allow future airport travelers to bypass four sets of traffic lights and a rail crossing and is expected to save up to 10 minutes on their trip. American Infrastructure is the design-build contractor for the project. Construction is expected to be complete by March 2011.
